Teams NEED Coaches! If you have been a coach before, or are interested in becoming a coach - here are some details:

Minimum Requirements & Certifications: Police Check, Respect-in-Sport Leadership Certification, Safety Certification, and completing the Online Registration with Southwest Hockey.

NEW: Respect-in-Sport Leadership expires <u>every 4 seasons.</u> To verify if your certification is still valid, log in to your <u>Respect-in-Sport</u> account, or you can also check your <u>e-hockey account</u>.

Volunteer Bond Information for the 2019-2020 Season

Southwest Hockey relies heavily on the involvement of volunteers to ensure that the hockey program, and all events are sufficiently covered, so they run with ease and efficiency. Without the participation of the membership's **valuable time and efforts**, the hockey program and events would be at risk, as they may not provide as much of an enjoyable experience as hoped.

Southwest Hockey does have a Volunteer Bond Program in place, with MANY ways to become involved. Here is some information, and reminders as we head into another season:

The Volunteer Bond requirement, remains at a minimum of 15 hours per family; from the Timbits to Midget Community Program only.

While it seems antiquated, cheques are still the simplest and most cost effective method of collecting postdated payments. Ensure you have cheques on hand, as the postdated cheque will be required when your player(s) check-in for evaluations. If you don't have cheques on hand, this would be a good time to order some. **NOTE**: Money Orders and Cash will not be accepted for the postdated payment.
