Registrations completed AFTER August 6th, will be accepted based on availability, and are subject to a late fee (for returning SWH Members).

The late fee is \$200 PER player, & takes effect on August 7, 2019

Registration Priority Deadline!

Registration will be open to members of Southwest Hockey, as a priority, until Thursday August 1st.

Update: Coaches please ensure you are using the PROPER LINK to register. Your link, as a Coach, is DIFFERENT from the player registration.

Teams NEED Coaches! If you have been a coach before, or are interested in becoming a coach - here are some details:

Minimum Requirements & Certifications: Police Check, Respect-in-Sport Leadership Certification, Safety Certification, and completing the Online Registration with Southwest Hockey.

NEW: Respect-in-Sport Leadership expires <u>every 4 seasons.</u> To verify if your certification is still valid, log in to your <u>Respect-in-Sport</u> account, or you can also check your <u>e-Hockey Account</u>.

Visit the Southwest Hockey website for details on these certifications, as well as the instructions on how to register and become a coach. Click on the "Hockey Coaches Wanted" image, to take you to the Coaches tab.

If you would like to be considered for a coaching position, complete the instructions that have been provided. If you need some (or all of the requirements/certifications), then please don't delay as the certification clinics can fill up fast & the Police Checks can also take some time as well.
