Evaluation Schedule - The evaluation schedules for each Age Division have now been posted to the SWH website.

Reminders for the season:

- 1) If you do not have a blank cheque, now is good time to get one! Despite many suggestions, this remains the cheapest and simplest format for post-dated payments. Thanks for understanding!
- 2) Please bring your filled out <u>Volunteer Bond Agreement Form</u> and postdated cheque <u>to your child's</u> <u>first evaluation skate</u>. For families with multiple children, whatever child skates first is a good time to take care of this task, for the family!
- 3) The Welcome Table will try to only ask you once for your form/cheque. However, if you happen to be asked again for your form, we ask for understanding and politeness when responding; due to the volume of players coming through.
- 4) Your child's team placement will be withheld until the VB form and cheque is received. Let's avoid this delay to the start of your season.
- 5) If your hours are **fully completed PRIOR TO** your child's evaluation skates, please submit a Time/Credit Form, in lieu of your Volunteer Bond Form and cheque.
- 6) Only postdated cheques will be accepted. No cash or money orders will be accepted for the volunteer bond.
- 7) The volunteer bond requirement remains at a minimum of 15 hours per family, for the Timbits to Midget Community Program, only.
