SW Hockey in partnership with Hockey Calgary are continuing to work on the plans with getting the players back on the ice! Please know that **many efforts** are being put towards the protocols that must be in alignment with Alberta Health and our governing bodies. As updated information comes available to SW Hockey, members will be notified via email.

Registration Information:

Respect in Sport (RIS): is a mandatory program under the playing rules of Hockey Alberta and Hockey Calgary. Members must ensure their RIS is current; as re-certification is required every 4-seasons. Registrations will be considered incomplete if RIS is missing or expired. To confirm your expiry date, or to take the course, please --- <u>Click</u> **Here**

Hockey Canada ID# (HCR): In order to complete your player registration(s), you will require their HCR ID#. To review the options for retrieving this number --- **Click Here**

Payments: Southwest Hockey has various options for registration fees to be paid. Members can; pay in full, take advantage of the payment plans, and there is also financial assistance available. Save the Date

Southwest Hockey has now scheduled the Annual General Meeting, in alignment with AHS guidelines.

<u>Please note:</u> There will be no discussions at the AGM about the upcoming season. Information about the upcoming season will be communicated to members via email; as it becomes available.

<u>Pre-registration is Required</u>: With AHS restrictions, there are limits to the number of attendees permitted. At this time, only one (1) member per family can attend - which will allow a broader reach of families who would like to come to the AGM.

Interested in Coaching?

Coaching applications for the 2020-2021 season opens on Friday July 10th.

Please read the following criteria related to applying for a coaching position, as some processes have changed from prior seasons with regards to who needs to sign up for an interview.

Process to Apply:

<u>Step #1:</u> Complete the registration in TeamSnap - <u>BEFORE</u> scheduling an interview. If the online registration is not completed, your name will not appear on the list of candidates.

<u>Step #2:</u> Once your HCR registration is confirmed, you will receive an email from the Registrar containing the certifications that are on file, and if a Police Check is required.

Step #3: If a Police Check is required, send the letter in ASAP, according to the instructions that would have been provided.

<u>Step #4:</u> Those applying for a Head Coach position, <u>only need to book an interview if ANY OF THE THREE criteria apply.</u>

- Any candidate who has not previously served as a Head Coach within Southwest Minor Hockey.
- Any candidate who has not served as a Head Coach within the past two seasons (2018/2019 or 2019/2020).
- Candidates who have only served as an Assistant Coach.

In-person interviews will be conducted for Head Coach candidates beginning the week of July 13th.

Step #5: Those registering as an Assistant Coach only, no interview is required.

 Assistant Coach registrations only require you to complete the online registration & police check (if applicable) to be considered.

Important to Note:

Those who did serve as a Head Coach last season do not require an in-person interview this year.

Not having an interview, will not limit your chances to attain a Head Coach position for this coming season.

<u>As deemed necessary</u>, the Director of Coaches <u>may</u> reach out to candidates who were Head Coaches last season to ensure there are no outstanding 'loose ends', due to the abrupt end to the season.
