

## OCA PROCEDURES AND GUIDELINES WHILE USING THE FACILITY

Please ensure your Participants and Representatives are following these Guidelines during your facility booking.

- When entering the facility, please use the front main doors, when exiting, please use the same front entry doors. When you enter and exit and in the hallway on your way to your designated dressing room, **Please, stay to the RIGHT.**
- The City of Calgary has mandated the use of face masks when you are entering, leaving, in the dressing rooms, and bleachers of our facility. If you are our guest and not wearing a mask as per the **City of Calgary Bylaw # 26M2020**, you will immediately be asked to leave.
- Access to the facility will be **20** minutes prior to your ice booking. **Dressing rooms will be locked until that time and unavailable to you.** PLEASE DO NOT CONGREGATE IN THE LOBBY. Please vacate the dressing room within 15 minutes after your session has ended.
- Limit of 50 participants per ice slot.
- All participants **MUST** come dressed in their on-ice gear. Dressing rooms will be assigned 2 per ice slot, however, there is limited space available while observing social distancing. **No showers will be allowed.**
- Parents may use the lobby to tie skates for those children not yet able to tie their own skates. **To preserve the integrity of the player/coach cohort, PARENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE DRESSING ROOMS.**
- Participants must NOT dress in the hallways and foyers. Participants must remain in the dressing room until notified by the coach or team representative that they should proceed to either the ice surface or to exit the building. **A supervisor must be assigned to each dressing room to monitor participants as to social distancing, horseplay and roughhousing at EACH ice time.**
- Spectators will be limited to one per participant at this time, **NO SIBLINGS ALLOWED** social distancing is required. Masks are mandatory while in the stands and gloves are recommended by AHS.
- Spitting, anywhere in the facility is forbidden.
- The lobby drinking fountain will not be available. Please ensure that each participant has and uses their own water bottle.

Discuss with all participants prior to entering the facility that things have changed. If we want the season to progress these changes need to be **taken seriously** to avoid additional restrictions or future facility shutdowns.
