Player Pathway Program

The Player Pathway Program is supported by the Hockey Canada Long-Term Player Development Model. This framework provides the guiding principles for age appropriate and skill specific programming for all players in Hockey Canada's youth hockey system.

Hockey Canada mandates that every U11 player must be provided a minimum of four (4) ice sessions prior to formal tryouts starting. A player's first experience in the new hockey season should not be a formal tryout.

The Pathway Skates give players the opportunity to get back on the ice in a more 'player-friendly' environment as a way of helping to 'even the playing field'; as not all players go to hockey schools or prep camps prior to the start of the season.
