

Government of Alberta Mandate

The Government of Alberta announced a new masking mandate for the Province of Alberta. Unless otherwise notified, the mandate is being interpreted as follows:

- 1. Face masks are not required by any player on the ice, or on the players' bench.
- 2. Face masks are not required by coaches or on-ice officials while on the ice surface during sport / physical activity.
- 3. Face masks ARE required by coaches and team staff while on the bench, and by all penalty / timekeeping volunteers.
- 4. Face masks ARE required by everyone while in a dressing room.

In addition, the facilities in which Southwest Hockey has ice contracts --- face masks ARE also mandatory. Please follow and respect ALL facility protocols.

Together WE can ALL help ensure our kids can continue to PLAY in sports!
