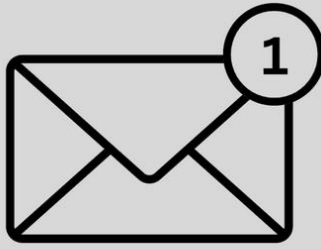


Coaching Considerations!
